Innovation staff are participating in the Global Institute for Tomorrow's Young Leaders Programme, Pingzhang Project, China, which commences in June 2007.

The project is helping the villagers of a poor rural community in far-western China to take the first steps towards control of their own future.

The villagers of Pingzhang Administrative Village in Yunnan province's Baoshan prefecture are to be the focus of the programme. One of the aims of the YLP is to help people who want to help themselves and to take hold of their own future and retain dignity; and, at the same time recognise the importance of ecological balance and self-sufficiency.

The China programme is the third in a continuing series of unique projects that aim to change the way business executives think by giving them a life-changing experience.

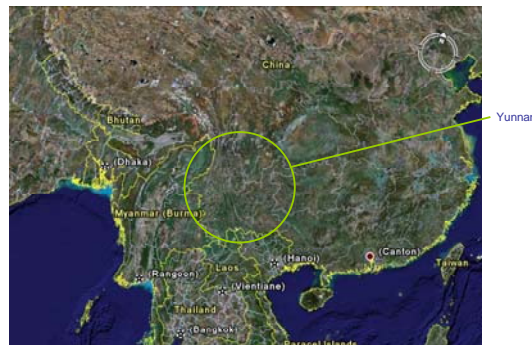
