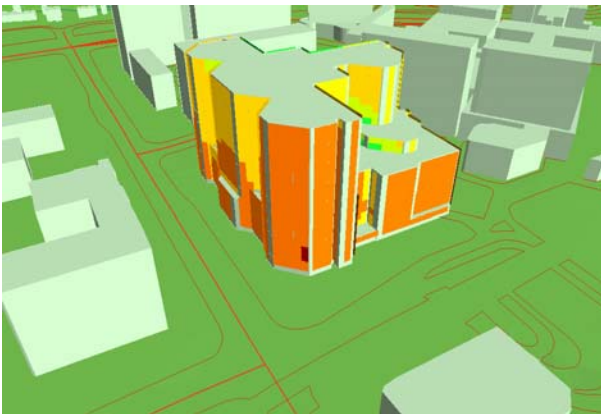


Still Holding Our Breath...
